

Be it further RESOLVED, that we, the members of the Illinois Republican Party, urge elected leaders of the United States to withhold funding from any state agency that engages in religious discrimination; and

Be it further RESOLVED, that we, the members of the Illinois Republican Party strongly oppose the exposure of children to resources and activities in public school that either implicitly or explicitly contradict the religious beliefs of their families; and

Be it further RESOLVED, that we, the members of the Illinois Republican Party, pledge ourselves to the preservation of religious liberty which has been good both for the state and for the Church in our nation and is protected in the constitutions of the United States and Illinois; and

Be it further RESOLVED, that we, the members of the Illinois Republican Party, recognize that the future health of the United States and its citizens depends on the preservation of religious liberty, and, therefore, we oppose government intrusion into the affairs of religious groups and their agencies; and

Be it finally RESOLVED, that we, the members of the Illinois Republican Party urge elected leaders of the United States to pursue only policies and laws that recognize and respect the right of all citizens to exercise their God-given religious liberty.
